

BackPack Weekend Food Program, Inc.

The BackPack Weekend Food Program is the outgrowth of an extensive study of the nutritional needs of school-aged children in Gaston County over the weekend especially during the school year. Hunger and improper nourishment interferes with a child's development, education, and socialization. Students who come to school hungry cannot learn.

The BackPack Weekend Food Program is designed to create partnerships between local churches or organizations and a school to provide selected students a bag of non-perishable, nutritious food that they can eat over the weekend. The students selected for the program are recommended by school counselors, social workers, teachers, school nurses and principals.

South Point Baptist will be starting its 5th year with the BackPack Program this coming school year. This last year we were able to provide 9 children with food from the BPWFP. It takes many volunteers from our church to successfully provide the food each week during the school year.
