.01 What is a skill, hobby, or activity that you'd like to get better at?

family DEVOTION

Consider following up with your student later in the week with the following summary and discussion questions.

summary: PHILIPPIANS 1:1-11

In this session, we learn that God was moving in the hearts of the believers at Philippi, and that this brought the apostle Paul great joy. The Philippians had matured in their faith and become more devoted to the gospel after Paul had left Philippi, and he was thrilled to hear about their spiritual maturity. This moved Paul to pray for their continued growth.

discussion QUESTIONS

.01 Why was Paul so thankful for the believers in Philippi? Why should we be thankful for the spiritual growth of our friends and other fellow believers?

.02 Who did Paul say was responsible for starting this work in the Philippians, and who would complete it? Do you think he was correct? Why or why not?

PRAY: Pray that God would continue to work in you, your family, your friends, and your church to strengthen your faith, love, knowledge, and discernment.
