Consider following up with your student later in the week with the following summary and discussion questions.

summary: COLOSSIANS 3:1-17

In this week's session, we see Paul tell the Colossians to long for Jesus' rule to be demonstrated in our hearts and lives so that we might point more people to Jesus. He instructs his readers to put aside their old, selfish desires and to "put on"—like fine clothing—the beautiful and praiseworthy characteristics of our new selves, such as compassion, humility, kindness, forgiveness, and above all, love.

discussion QUESTIONS

.01 Why is it important for our faith to move us to live transformed lives and to demonstrate the qualities and attributes Paul lists in verse 12-17?

.02 How can we practice putting aside our "earthly nature" and encourage one another, as a community, to look to the ways of Jesus instead?
