These are simple questions to ask your students as you go home from church or go about your weekly activities.

- .01** What is something you didn't understand when you were younger, but understand better now?
- .02** Why was that thing confusing or mysterious to you before? How did you gain more understanding about it?

family DEVOTION

Consider following up with your student later in the week with the following summary and discussion questions.

summary: COLOSSIANS 1:24-2:3

Paul was able to rejoice even in his sufferings because he knew that suffering was benefiting the church as well as aiding in the spread of the gospel. In this week's session we will see him mention "the mystery hidden for ages and generations" (Col. 1:26). What is this mystery? Paul is going to make clear what the mystery is and why it is good news: Jesus is both our Savior and King and He lives, by His Spirit, in all who trust in Him.

discussion QUESTIONS

- .01** How was Paul able to suffer joyfully for the gospel? What were some of the things he suffered and what was it accomplishing?
- .02** How does unity among believers (v. 2) help us to have greater understanding and faith?

PRAY: Thank God that He made a way for all people to be reunited to Him through faith in His Son. Thank God that Jesus is both our Savior, our King, and our example of living fully in God's will..

**CENTRAL truth**

Jesus is both our Savior and King and He lives, by His Spirit, in all who trust in Him.
