family DEVOTION

Consider following up with your student later in the week with the following summary and discussion questions.

summary: DANIEL 6:10-24

Daniel had gained favor with King Darius, and the other palace officials were looking for a way get rid of him. They had convinced the king to sign an edict that for thirty days, no one could worship any god other than the king himself. They hoped to catch Daniel in the act of praying to his God, and it looked like things were going exactly according to plan. Darius looked for a way around the law, but he couldn't make an exception for anyone, not even Daniel. He was forced to send Daniel to his death in the lions' pit. But Daniel knew, as we will see today, that only God is worthy of our ultimate trust, even in our greatest trials.

discussion QUESTIONS

.01 Why were the palace officials so eager to get rid of Daniel? Why was Darius displeased when they caught Daniel praying to his God?

.02 How did God use this situation for His glory? How does it point others to God when you trust Him in difficult situations?

PRAY: Thank God that we can trust He is working, even when things look hopeless and we can't see a way out. Ask Him to give you confidence in this as you go about your week.
